

## Seminar/Workshop details for 2020-2021

1. **Workshop - Workshop on "The Art of Yoga: The Way of Self-Belief and Spiritual Upliftment"**

**Report** – The workshop was conducted on International Yoga Day. Around 200 students participated in the programme. It was organized by NSS and the Physical Education Department, Shree Agrasen Mahavidyalaya. The trainer discussed the importance of Yoga in our daily life to keep our mental and physical health stable. There was live demonstration of several 'asanas' and students were highly benefited. Even the teachers also discussed with him their issues and each and issue was addressed by him in the workshop. The programme was online, but it was highly successful.

2. **Seminar - International Webinar on 'Debesh Roy and Anisuzzaman: Manane O Anweshane"**

**Report** – It was organized by the Department of Bengali in collaboration with IQAC of the College. In the Key-note speech of the discussion cycle, fiction writer Sri Kinnar Roy presented a literary counterpart of Debesh Roy in the style of weaving stories. Prof. (Dr.) Bikash Roy (Dean, University of Gour Banga, West Bengal) praised the talent and thoughtfulness of Debesh Roy and Anisuzzaman. Prof. (Dr.) Priyakanth Nath (Assam University, Assam) analyzed the Hindu-Muslim interrelationship in Debesh Roy's novel on public life in North Bengal and Bangladesh's liberation war. Two professors from Bangladesh participated in this webinar – Prof. (Dr.) Tapan Kumar Roy (Islamic University) and Prof. (Dr.) Rahel Rajib (Jagannath University). In the speech of Prof. Roy and Prof. Rahel, they highlighted the various aspects of the role Anisuzzaman played in the formation of a new state after the liberation war of Bangladesh. Besides, he highlighted the role of Muslim society in Bengali literature and Anisuzzaman's contribution in researching the sources of old Bengali prose. The promising thing is that about four hundred professors-researchers-students from different parts of West Bengal and about one hundred students from Bangladesh participated in this webinar.

**Report** - On the occasion of the 250th birth anniversary of Raja Rammohan Roy, a two-day International Webinar was organized on June 24-25, 2021 by the Department of Bengali and Department of History in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Shree Agrasen Mahavidyalaya.

The key-note address of this webinar was delivered by Prof. (Dr.) Shaktisadhan Mukherjee (Former Prof. Khidirpur College and Secretary of Bangiya Sahitya Parishad) It was followed by the lectures of other resource persons.

In the discussion, Raja Rammohan Roy as a person and his immense contributions was critically analyzed on the eve of his 250<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary. The discussion also highlighted how renaissance came in Bangladesh in the 19th century, how Rammohan Roy became an institution in the renaissance of Bangladesh and how the society will benefit if the present generation accepts Rammohan Roy's ideals in the formation of their life and society at large. Various aspects of emancipation of society were analyzed. Rammohan Roy's reforms in the economy of Bengal was also perceived in the discussion. The role of Rammohan Roy in the practice of Bengali literature and religion, the preparation of Bengali grammar books and the practice of Bengali grammar was also a part of the scholarly discussion.

The aim of this webinar was to convey the ideals and identity of a great social reformer in the assessment of Rammohan Roy's contribution in the past and in the future.

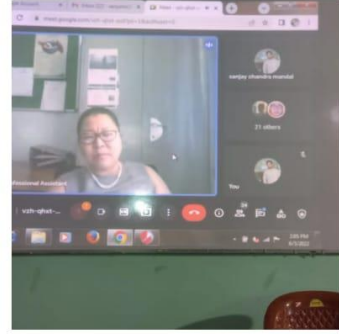
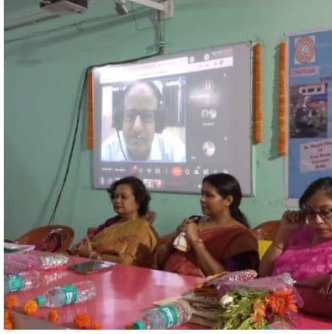
